## ORCHID POTTING MIX COIR BLOCK

### Introduction

- Suitable for most Australian Orchids and is ideal for Cymbidium Orchids.
- Open medium with excellent drainage
- Contains slow release fertiliser for LIFT OFF
- 100% COIR to ensure ideal moisture retention
- Light and easy to handle. Only 4kg makes up to 60L  
VS - EQUIVALENT BAGS OF ORCHID MIX = APPROX 26KG



*SIZES – AVAILABLE IN 15L & 60L SIZES*

### Expanding your Orchid Mix Block

Place the **EASY WETTA POTTING MIX COIR BLOCK** into a wheelbarrow, slowly add around 30 litres of water for the 60L Block. (7 Litres of water for the 15L Block). Allow to soak for a full 10 minutes. Pull apart and churn with your hands, ensuring that the entire mix is thoroughly wet and hydrated. Drain off excess water into the garden bed.

### For Best Results

#### **Repotting of Orchids:**

Re-potting should be done every two years, minimum, to replace growing material and prevent over crowding of roots. Do this after flowering.

Remove dead roots and leaves from your plant. Place two handfuls of large bark pieces at the bottom of the new pot. Don't block drainage holes. Centre plant in pot, hand fill the mix around root system. Compress mix without damaging roots. Continue process until pot is filled to bottom rim.

#### **Watering:**

Watering should always be a heavy soaking and then the plant should be left to dry. Water weekly in Summer and fortnightly in Winter. Do not over water. Brunnings Coir Orchid Potting Mix will retain adequate moisture in most conditions.

#### **Feeding:**

Feed regularly using light amounts of plant food. Orchids can be fed after each watering. Nitrophoska Slow Release provides all the nutrient requirements to promote healthy growth and beautiful flowers. Do not fertilise when orchids are dormant.
