ROSE PLANTING MIX COIR BLOCK

Introduction

- *Just Add Water – Expands in Minutes to 15 litres of PREMIUM COIR ROSE PLANTING MIX.*
- Ideal for re-potting and bare-rooted roses!
- Used and recommended by PROFESSIONAL ROSE GROWERS.
- Contains slow release fertiliser and combines good aeration with excellent moisture retention.
- Light and easy to handle. Only 1kg makes up to 15 litres.



Expanding to 15 Litres of Mix

Place the block into a wheelbarrow, container or garden bed. Slowly add around 7 litres of water. Allow to soak for a full 5 minutes. Now gently pull it apart and churn with your hands, ensuring that the entire mix is thoroughly wet and hydrated. Drain off excess water into the garden bed.

New Potting

Place a mound of *Coir Rose Planting Mix* in the bottom of the pot. Prune the rose branches and roots as necessary. Place the roots over the mound in a downward spiral and fill with mix to within 25mm of the top of the pot. The lowest bud should be about 13mm above the mix.

Re-Potting

If potting up to a bigger pot, cover the bottom with scoria or pebbles. Cover with layer of *Brunnings Coir Rose Planting Mix*. Gently tap the rose plant out of existing pot and insert in the centre of new pot. Do not remove the existing soil surrounding the root ball. Place *Coir Rose Planting Mix* around the side of the plant and water in well.

Top Dressing

If already in required pot, top dress annually. Carefully remove the top 25mm of old soil and replace with *Brunnings Coir Rose Planting Mix*.
